While poverty is a complex issue, we know that the answers are found in God. As our Creator and loving Father, He knows all of our physical, spiritual, social and emotional struggles, as well as their solutions. His desire is for us to know His truth, to bring every area of life under the lordship of Christ, to experience life to the full, and to bring glory to Him.
