

Genocide is an attempt to wipe out a particular people group, race, religion, or culture. As of April 2018, genocide is happening in 20 countries. In Myanmar, both the Rohingya and Kachin people are being targeted. Genocides in Sudan, South Sudan, and DR Congo have been going on for more than a decade. It is happening in Syria and Iraq, Somalia, Nigeria, Burundi...Millions of innocent women, men, and children have been murdered. Millions more have fled

for their lives, creating an unprecedented refugee crisis. According to the United Nations, there are currently 65,600,000 forcibly displaced people in

the world

It is an unspeakable, unfathomable evil. But, like all evil, it starts with a lie—the belief that one group is less valuable, or even less human, than another. This lie gives rise to an "us/them" mentality that leads to discrimination, dehumanization, and, ultimately, extermination. The truth is that every person is created in the image of God, with purpose and value. Our Maker loves and values us equally.

- for protection over all families, men, women, and children who are
 experiencing genocide, that they would be covered and surrounded
 with God's peace and safety. Pray that God would hear their cries for
 salvation from their enemies. Pray for healing and hope for those
 who have witnessed or endured violence. Pray that they would be
 able to forgive as Christ forgave, that they would not retaliate, but
 that they would be peacemakers.
- that the Church would know and live out God's love. Pray especially
 for unity within the Church, despite local religious or ethnic conflicts.
 Pray that the Church would be a beacon of light and truth to all
 people and would show God's love to each individual regardless of
 ethnic background.
- against any fear or apathy that might hinder onlookers from speaking up about the issues. Pray that God would raise up advocates.
 And as we speak out, pray that governments, organizations, and communities would hear the call and respond.
- for the end of these conflicts. Pray that governmental corruption would be rooted out and that justice would be restored. Pray that governments would advocate for peace and would defend all people equally.

We encourage you to meditate on these verses and pray them over people experiencing genocide.
