Many Christians believe the lie, "We aren't able to do anything; someone else needs to address this issue."

Wherever the Church is in bondage to these lies, those outside the church tend to see the Christian God as either imaginary, weak or uninterested in the affairs of earth. God is not glorified, and communities remain trapped in poverty. Yet, Christ loves His bride and wants to bless her. When the Church operates as God intended, the results are incredible, and ultimately bring glory to God.
