How to Pray the truth... GOD IS POWERFUL

Throughout the Majority World, many people are very aware of the power of the spiritual realm over their lives. They believe in and have experienced witchcraft, curses, and the need to appease spirits. Even Christians too often live in fear and spiritual oppression.

Those who are most vulnerable—the poor and uneducated, women, and ethnic minorities (to name a few)—are also keenly aware of the need to appease people who have wealth, privilege, and authority. The decisions and actions of those in power can have significant impact on the lives of vulnerable people.

The truth that God is powerful is truly good news. God is unfailingly good and wise, and He is King over human kings, Lord over human lords, and stronger than any evil in the spiritual realm. As churches experience God's power to deliver them from both human and supernatural evil, they are freed from feeling helpless in the face of other powers.

Jesus called His twelve disciples to Him and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness... "As you go, proclaim this message: 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give." Matthew 10:1, 7, 8
