

The opportunity for education often makes the difference between desperation and flourishing. Statistically, equitable education leads to better health, higher incomes, and more stable societies. Yet, many children face incredible barriers. Decent teachers aren't willing to work in poor areas. There are rundown schools, overcrowding, lack of supplies... Many children walk 2-5 miles to get to school. But the biggest barrier to education is often people's mindset. Too many believe that some—because they are girls or disabled or part of a minority group or destined to be farmers—simply don't need an education or aren't capable of learning.

While these problems are widespread and very real, we also see God's people overcoming these challenges in thousands of communities around the world. One pastor in Southeast Asia, after learning that all people have great value to God, became a champion for girls' education; he persuaded 70 villages to send girls to school. In Africa and India, Christians have risen up to help make sure deaf children and students with autism have equal access to education. Churches are cleaning school grounds, building classrooms, and buying school supplies. As the church learns God's concern for every area of life and begins to value education, school attendance grows and students flourish.

Instruct the wise and they will be wiser still; teach the righteous and they will add to their learning. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. For through wisdom your days will be many, and years will be added to your life.

 shepherd the children in their care. Pray for teachers with passion,
 knowledge, and skill. Pray that more Christians would feel called into
 education and would have a biblical perspective of their role in the
 lives of students.
- Pray for government ministries of education—that they would act justly, seeing all children as having potential and providing equal access to education. Pray that God will raise up Christians in government who know that all people are made in God's image and advocate for those who have been overlooked or under-resourced.
