How to Pray About... DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Computers, phones, and internet connection can be blessings from God. With them, we can gain information, connect with one another, and work more efficiently. Millions of people have heard the gospel via radio, TV, and internet. Many receive Bible lessons on their cell phones. During the pandemic, prayer groups and Bible studies have met virtually. Digital technology enabled many businesses, churches, and family gatherings to continue despite lockdowns. In many ways, we can stay better connected to our support systems and loved ones than ever before.

And yet, in our broken world, digital technology can also do great harm. For the most part, time using screens is time spent in isolation. It can lead to depression, broken and neglected relationships, and poor physical health. Most pornography exposure now happens online. Pornography and social media can both create addiction—adolescent brains are especially vulnerable. Too often, time online replaces our time in scripture and prayer—it harms our relationship with God and drowns out His still, small voice. Social media ends up shaping Christians' thinking more than scripture does. Dependence on digital technology to avoid boredom, access endless information, and obtain constant social feedback can turn a useful tool into an idol that controls us.
