According to the <u>World Health Organization</u>, there are approximately 7 doctors for every 10,000 people in India and Myanmar. Throughout many parts of Africa, that number drops to just 1-2 doctors per 10,000. This huge lack in healthcare means that illnesses can spread quickly and frequently as disease and poor hygiene overcome communities.

Too many communities suffer from constant diseases. When poor health is the norm, it can be almost impossible to make progress on any other development issue. Along with the viruses common everywhere, they face

serious illness and death from contaminated water, lack of hygiene infrastructure, worms, parasites, bacteria, and chronic malnutrition. Too many communities still have no medical clinic nearby. Most believers have no idea that God cares about their bodies, because they've been taught only about God's concern for their salvation and spiritual lives. Yet God has not abandoned these communities to disease. His desire is for their abundant life, and He is able to use churches to transform their communities' health.
